"CHALWIN CASTLE", commenced in 1951, is the work of its designer-builder-owner, VIVIAN JAMES CHALWIN. It is in the "picturesque" 18th Century style, with Georgian Neo-Classical interiors.

The "18th Century Theatre" is designed for chamber music, opera and plays, and is made available free of charge to recognised music societies and clubs and charity organisations.

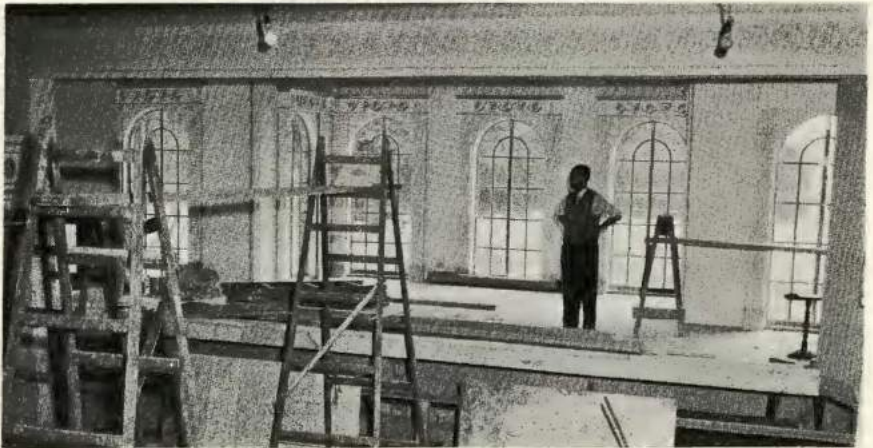

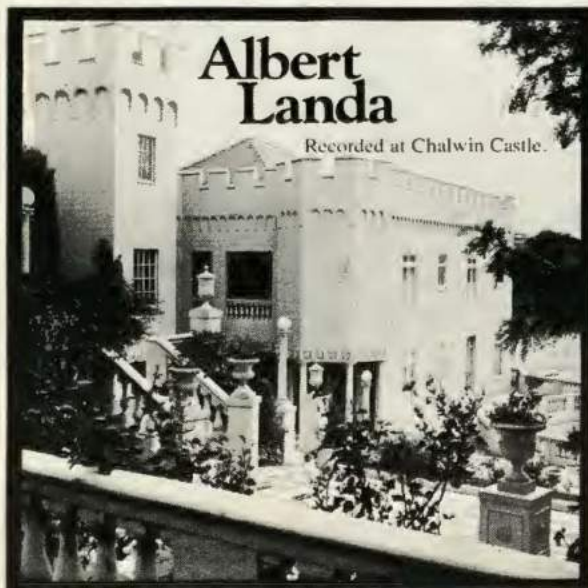

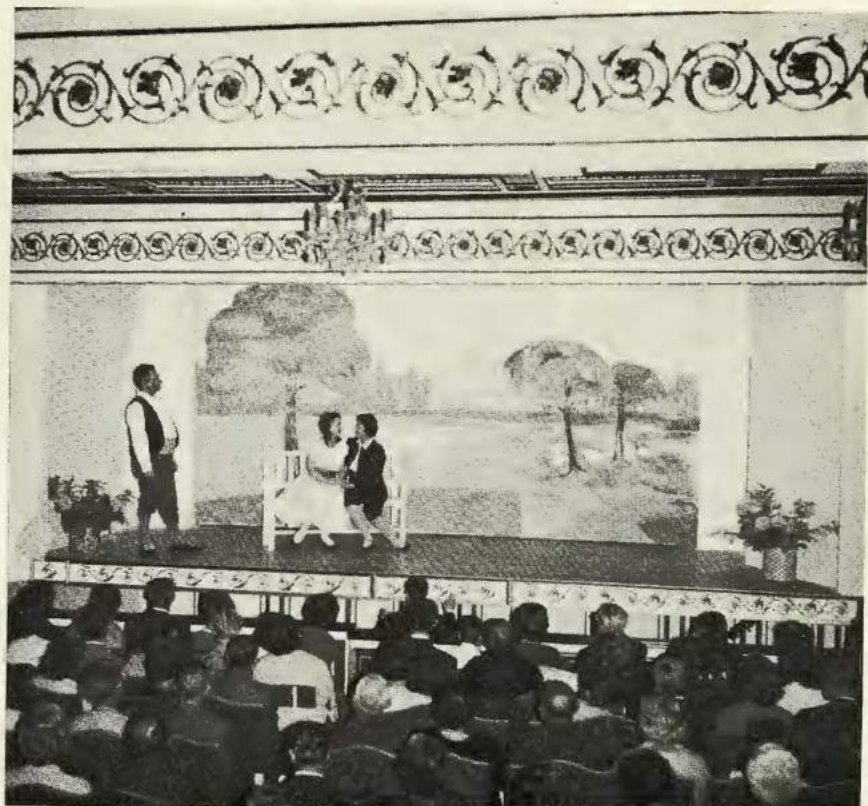
